

RTA Leadership Crew

A program for rising 6th grade and above that will encourage role modeling for younger students, taking on extra responsibilities and allowing the students to assist teachers within guidelines. There will be limited spots available each week. All members of the leadership crew are required to fill out an application for a position.

Program Explanation

1. **Role Models**- To lead and set example for fellow and younger students in order to create a respectful and safe camp environment.

- Enthusiasm during all Theater, Art and Game times
- Being respectful of all Teachers and fellow student in speech and action
- Assist teachers by taking on Crew positions for the week

2. Crew Positions

- **Announcements**- Students will begin each morning group time with announcements, buck exchange, schedule reading, etc. assisted by the Teacher
- **Lunch Activity Crew**- Students will coordinate informal, student activities for after lunch during the week while assisted by the Teacher. They will organize a mix of games/activities that include improv, skits, theater games, board games, etc.
- **Peer Helper**- Students will assist in making new students feel welcome and get their bearings, assist younger students with learning lines throughout week, and generally encouraging positive friendships throughout camp
- **Office Assistant**- Students will assist Drama Teacher and Art Teacher with any paperwork/set design & prep and general setup and breakdown of Theater and/or Art rooms (ex. collating scripts, passing out scripts during rehearsals, helping to set up theater on Friday, and breakdown/cleaning of Dance room after snack daily)
- **Performance Duties Possibilities** – Lights and Sound, Prompter, Prop Master or a part in the play. These duties are at the RTA's staffs discretion
